Do you need a vaccine right away and have orders to deploy overseas or out/in-processing?

Deployers leaving in 30 days, with orders, can walk in.

7:45-9 a.m. & Noon-1 p.m.

Flu Walk-in Lines

- Immunizations organizes 12-15 Flu vaccine lines yearly at different locations on base for active duty members.
- Active duty can attend any line that bests suits their schedule.

Occupational Health

For Hepatitis B vaccines and TB skin tests for healthcare workers, walk-in 7:45-8:15 a.m. & Noon-1 p.m. No TB testing/reads on Thursdays or holidays.

FAQs

- When am I due for a vaccine? Active duty can check ASIMs IMR. Select "worksheet." Everyone can get a copy of their record on the MHS GENESIS Patient Portal. Send a message to Immunizations if you need more info. CDC schedule links are in this brochure.
- What COVID vaccine do you offer? Pfizer, ages 6 months+, as supply allows.
- What Flu vaccine do you carry? When?
 Typically, we carry regular dose flu vaccines from the end of November to the end of June, for ages 6 months and older.
- Do you carry the Shingrix shingles vaccine? Yes, those 50 years and older can get it without a prescription. Ages 19-49 need a prescription.
- Do I need a prescription for vaccines?
 Typically, no. Routine scheduled vaccines for kids and adults do not need a prescription (i.e., Flu, COVID, well-visits.) However, vaccines for travel or special populations may require one. (i.e., No spleen, chronic illness, Shingrix <50yo)</p>
- Do you perform TB skin testing? Yes.
 Mon, Tue, Wed, Fri (unless 3-day weekend);
 read 48-72 hours after, 7:45 8:15 a.m., or noon 1 p.m.
- Do you offer alternate pediatric vaccine schedules? We adhere to the CDC recommended vaccine schedules. Any alternative schedule needs to be recommended by your pediatrician
- How to update my vaccine record? Fax record to 228-376-0190, attach record to MHS GENESIS message to Immunizations, or drop copy off at our front desk.

Click "Immunizations" tab, and then select any child 16 years old and younger, print DD2766 for record, and select "worksheet" for when next vaccines are due. For 17 years and up, send message per below.

- -"Schedule New Appointment" on left tab.
- -Under "How would you like to begin your search?", choose "Visit Reason," then "Visit Reason" again.
- -Choose patient name, then select
- "Immunization Appointment" on dropdown, then "Search."
- -Select "Air Force Medicine Keesler Immunization Clinic."
- Search by first available or by date. Do <u>not</u> select a specific provider.
